#### A George I Burr Walnut Bureau Cabinet

## England, circa 1720

This cabinet features burr walnut veneers of the finest quality with feather banding and fine cross mouldings. The interior is constructed of wainscot oak, a particularly type of oak noted for its fine grain and lack of imperfections. This type of oak had to be imported from the Baltic.

An exceptional George I walnut and parcel gilt bureau cabinet. The molded broken arched cornice with carved giltwood finials above two conforming doors, opening to reveal pigeonholes, niches, and drawers, centred by a small cupboard with beveled mirrored door that conceals secret drawers, the slant font opening to reveal a writing surface and interior with further drawers and pigeonholes, the base with three short and three long feather banded figured drawers and supported on bracket feet.

Retaining the original metalwork.
