JANSEN: A set of four giltwood fauteuils

France, *circa* 1890

These beautifully carved armchairs, in the manner of Georges Jacob, relate closely in design and detail to those supplied to Queen Marie Antoinette for the Château de Saint-Cloud as illustrated in Pierre Kjellberg, *Le mobilier français du XVIIIe siècle: dictionnaire des ébénistes et des menuisiers*, Paris: Les Éditions de l'Amateur; 2002. (no. 420).

A superb set of FOUR French late 19th century carved giltwood fauteuils by Jansen.

In the Louis XVI style, in the manner of George Jacob, each show-frame carved with great detail throughout with overlapping discs, acanthus and paterae, with cartouche shaped back, rounded seat frame, and standing on elegant stop-fluted tapering circular legs. The back, seat and armrests upholstered.

The underside of each fauteuil bearing the inkstamp: 'JANSEN, PARIS'.

The carved detail of exceptional quality and crispness.
