A GEORGE I GILT GESSO MIRROR

England, *circa* 1720

A very closely related mirror was descrived and illustrated in *Connoisseur*, March 1932, p. 184, part of the Warner collection, subsequently sold Sotheby's and advertised in *The Burlington Magazine*, October 1970, p. xvii

A set of three very closely related and of virtually identical size were formerly in the Percival Griffiths collection.

A superb George I gilt gesso mirror, with a beautiful bevelled double arched plate. The cresting centred by a winged chrub with sunflower halo and flanked by three dimensional scrolls. The gilt gesso decoration with fine punchwork and carved scrolling foliage.
