



**A LARGE IMARI LAMP**

**Japan, circa 1880**

A superb very large 19th century Japanese Imari vase, of baluster form, decorated in the typical Imari palette of iron reds and blue with gilt highlights, but also blacks and greens, on a predominantly white background, with cartouche panels depicting courtly figures in a garden and pavilion landscapes, the panels interspersed with flowering chrysanthemums and pomegranates, above which are smaller panels with gilded cranes, now mounted as a lamp with hand gilded turned base.

Height of vase: 22 1/2 in (57 cm) including giltwood base but excluding electrical fitting and lampshade.
