THE DUKE OF MANCHESTER - KIMBOLTON CASTLE

England, circa 1710 - 1715

These magnificent chairs come from a suite of furniture commissioned by Charles Montagu (1662 - 1722), 1st Duke of Manchester, for Kimbolton Castle, Huntingdonshire (now Cambridgeshire), his country estate. Two chairs from the suite appear in an illustration of "The Saloon" of Kimbolton Castle in a 1911 issue of *Country Life* - a photograph in a successive issue shows two chairs on either side of the door to "The Red Drawing Room".
