A PAIR OF JAPANESE IMARI LAMPS

Japan, circa 1900

A fine pair of Japanese Imari vases, the baluster bodies decorated with continuous landscapes with *Komainu* flanked by dense chrysanthemum blossom and flowering trees in underglaze blue and iron red and green enamels, the waisted necks similarly with formalised iron red wide bands, the footrims with compartmented underglaze blue plain borders, now mounted as lamps with hand gilded turned bases.

Height of vases: 13 in (33 cm) including giltwood bases, excluding electrical fittings and lampshades.
