A PAIR OF SAMSON LAMPS

France, Late 19th Century

A superb pair of late 19th century French Samson porcelain baluster vases decorated in the Chinese export *famille rose* palette. Of octagonal form, the vases moulded with elongated panels of alternating figural landscapes and flower and foliage amidst stylised rock work, on a background of dense scrolling flowering chrysanthemums, within floral and lotus borders, the bases with striped borders, the necks with alternating moulded cartouches of birds and flowers on a pink trellis ground, now mounted as lamps with hand gilded turned bases.
