A GEORGE III MAHOGANY SERPENTINE SERVING TABLE

A very fine George III mahogany serpentine serving table in the neoclassical manner. Inspired by the designs of Robert Adam, The well figured serpentine top over a fluted frieze with central tablet incorporating an oval patera flanked by bell flower swags and a moulding lower edge. The table is supported on four square section tapering fluted legs, each with floral paterae to the top and terminating in block feet. The table has excellent colour and patina throughout.
