This exceptional chest was part of the celebrated Parry Collection, noted for its emphasis on fine craftsmanship and proportion, unusual detail and in particular on magnificent colour and patina.

A similar chest-of-drawers with identical metal-work, a veneered brushing-slide and identical feather-banding, is illustrated in *The Somerset House Art Treasures Exhibition Catalogue*, November - December 1979, no. 71, described as 'having the original and most unusual brasses'.

An exceptionally fine and rare early 18th century George I period burr walnut caddy top chest of drawers. Of small scale, and with superb colour and patina. The veneered top with moulded edge over a brushing slide and a combination of two short drawers over three long graduated drawers and all with original brass handles and escutcheons, and standing on bracket feet.
